

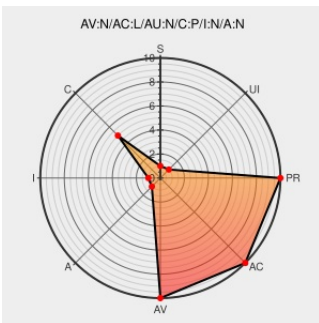

Absolute path traversal vulnerability in SysAid On-Premise before 14.4.2 allows remote attackers to read arbitrary files via a \\ (four backslashes) in the fileName parameter to getRdsLogFile.
