

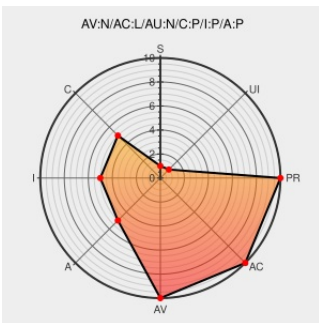

Certain versions of [Mantisbt](#) from [Mantisbt](#) contain the following vulnerability:

MantisBT before 1.2.19 and 1.3.x before 1.3.0-beta.2 does not properly restrict access to `/*/install.php`, which allows remote attackers to obtain database credentials via the `install` parameter with the value `4`.
