

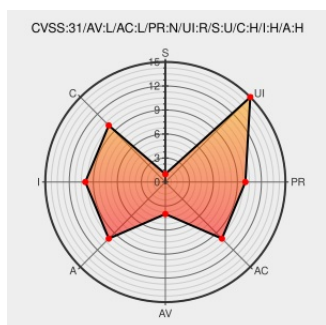

Certain versions of [Vlc Media Player](#) from [Videolan](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Integer overflow in the Encode function in modules/codecs/schroedinger.c in VideoLAN VLC media player before 2.1.6 and 2.2.x before 2.2.1 allows remote attackers to conduct buffer overflow attacks and execute arbitrary code via a crafted length value.

CVE-2014-9629 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
