Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer overflow in drivers/video/fbcmmap.c in the Qualcomm components in Android before 2016-07-05 on Nexus 7 (2013) devices allows attackers to gain privileges via a crafted application, aka Android internal bug 28410333 and Qualcomm internal bug CR556471.

CVE-2014-9781 has been assigned by security@android.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
