Certain versions of [Imagemagick](#) from [Imagemagick](#) contain the following vulnerability:

coders/pnm.c in ImageMagick 6.9.0-1 Beta and earlier allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (crash) via a crafted png file.

CVE-2014-9837 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
