

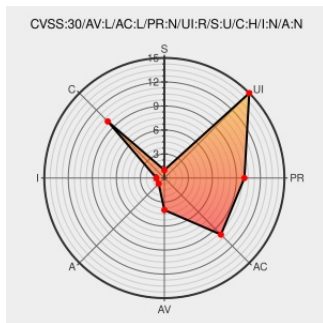

Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The `ethtool_get_wol` function in `net/core/ethtool.c` in the Linux kernel through 4.7, as used in Android before 2016-08-05 on Nexus 5 and 7 (2013) devices, does not initialize a certain data structure, which allows local users to obtain sensitive information via a crafted application, aka Android internal bug 28803952 and Qualcomm internal bug

CR570754.

CVE-2014-9900 has been assigned by security@android.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
