Certain versions of [Dynosaur-rails](#) from [Harrys](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability has been found in harrystech Dynosaur-Rails and classified as critical. Affected by this vulnerability is the function `basic_auth` of the file `app/controllers/application_controller.rb`. The manipulation leads to improper authentication. This product does not use versioning. This is why information about affected and unaffected

releases are unavailable. The patch is named `04b223813f0e336aab50bff140d0f5889c31dbec`. It is recommended to apply a patch to fix this issue. The associated identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-221503.

CVE-2015-10083 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
