

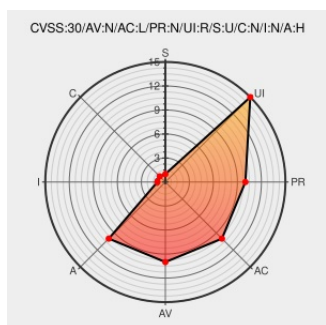

Certain versions of [Debian Linux](#) from [Debian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Double-free vulnerability in libavformat/mov.c in FFMPEG in Google Chrome 41.0.2251.0 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (memory corruption and crash) via a crafted .m4a file.

CVE-2015-1207 has been assigned by [Google](#) security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
