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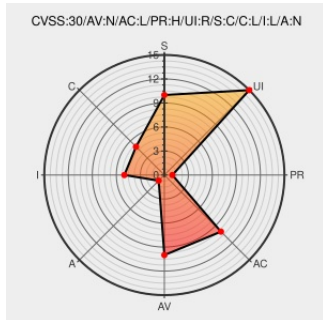

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Certain versions of [Phpbugtracker](#) from [Phpbugtracker Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in Issuetracker phpBugTracker before 1.7.2 allow remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via unspecified parameters.

CVE-2015-2148 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
