Description	The nsZipArchive::BuildFileList function in Mozilla Firefox before 39.0, Firefox ESR 31.x before 31.8 and 38.x before 38.1, and Firefox ESR 31.8 before 31.8.0.1, 38.x before 38.0.5, and 38.0.5 before 38.0.5.1, allowed an attacker to cause a denial of service (DoS) by triggering a memory leak. The attacker can exploit this by sending a crafted ZIP file to the application. The vulnerability is caused by a buffer overflow in the nsZipArchive::BuildFileList function.
