

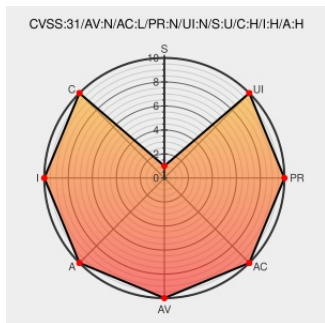

Certain versions of [File Transfer Appliance](#) from [Accellion](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Accellion File Transfer Appliance before FTA_9_11_210 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via shell metacharacters in the `oauth_token` parameter.

CVE-2015-2857 has been assigned by cert@cert.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
