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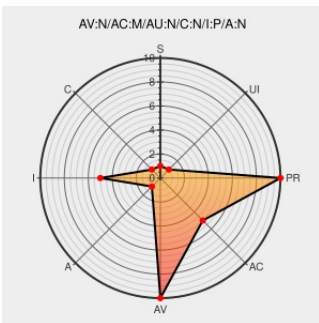

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in index.php in LEMON-S PHP Twit BBS allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the imagetitle parameter.
