

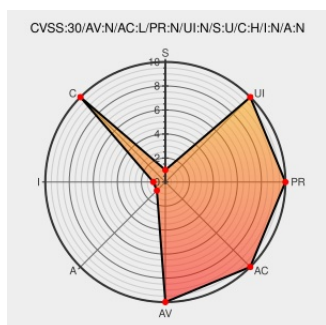

Certain versions of [Mod Nss](#) from [Mod Nss Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The mod_nss module before 1.0.11 in Fedora allows remote attackers to obtain cipher lists due to incorrect parsing of multi-keyword cipherstring.

CVE-2015-3277 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
