

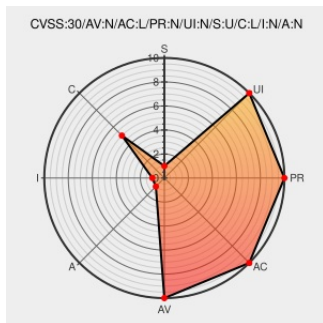

Certain versions of [Webaccess](#) from [Advantech](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Advantech WebAccess before 8.1 allows remote attackers to read sensitive cleartext information about e-mail project accounts via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2015-3943 has been assigned by [ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
