

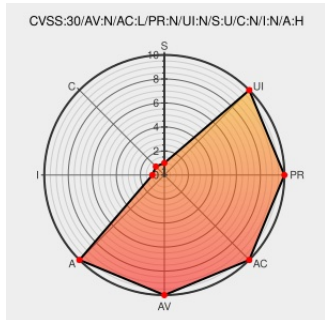

Certain versions of [Kdcproxy](#) from [Kdcproxy Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

python-kdcproxy before 0.3.2 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service via a large POST request.

CVE-2015-5159 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
