

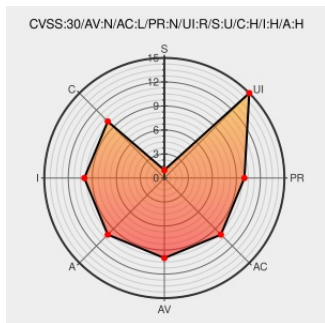

AxiomSL's Axiom Google Web Toolkit module 9.5.3 and earlier is vulnerable to a Session Fixation attack.
