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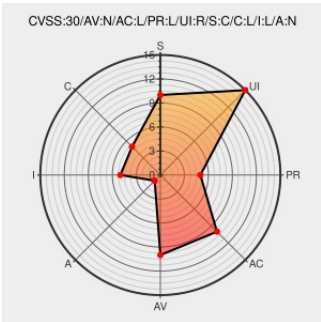

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Certain versions of [Phpvibe](#) from [Phpvibe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in PHPVibe before 4.21 allows remote authenticated users to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via a comment.

CVE-2015-5399 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
