

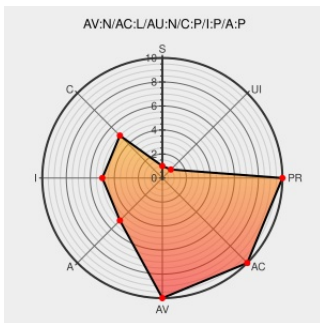

Buffer overflow in Ricoh DL FTP Server 1.1.0.6 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a long USER command.
