

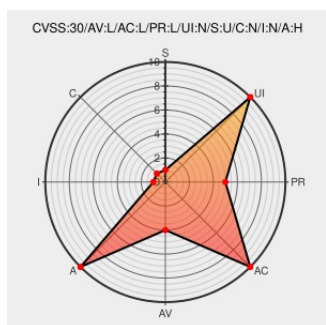

Certain versions of **i Access** from **ibm** contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer overflow in IBM i Access 7.1 on Windows allows local users to cause a denial of service (application crash) via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2015-7422 has been assigned by psirt@us.ibm.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
