

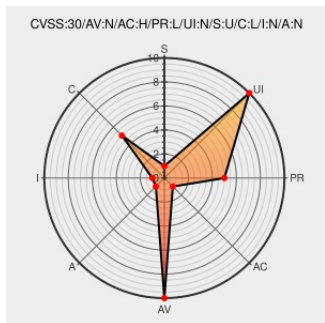

Certain versions of [Kubernetes](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Kubernetes in OpenShift3 allows remote authenticated users to use the private images of other users should they know the name of said image.

CVE-2015-7561 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
