Certain versions of [Yeager Cms](#) from [Yeager](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in Yeager CMS 1.2.1 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the "passwordreset&token" parameter.

CVE-2015-7567 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
