

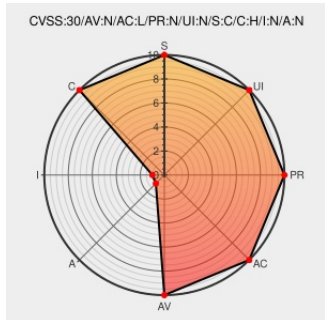

Certain versions of [Web Viewer](#) from [Samsung](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Web Viewer 1.0.0.193 on Samsung SRN-1670D devices allows remote attackers to read arbitrary files via a request to an unspecified PHP script.

CVE-2015-8279 has been assigned by cert@cert.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
