

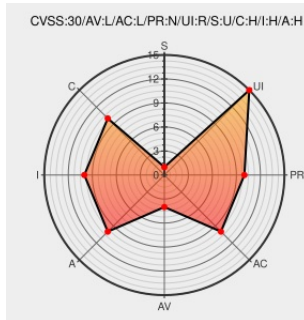

Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Integer overflow in app/about/about.c in the Qualcomm components in Android before 2016-07-05 on Nexus 5 devices allows attackers to bypass intended access restrictions via a crafted block count and block size of a sparse header, aka Android internal bug 28822465 and Qualcomm internal bug CR813933.

CVE-2015-8888 has been assigned by security@android.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
