

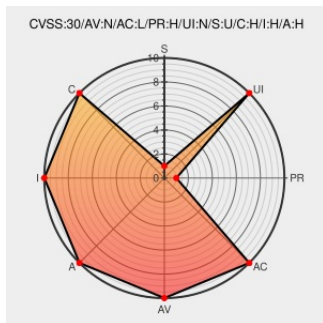

Certain versions of [Alegrocart](#) from [Alegrocart](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple SQL injection vulnerabilities in AlegroCart 1.2.8 allow remote administrators to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the download parameter in the (1) check\_download and possibly (2) check\_filename function in upload/admin2/model/products/model\_admin\_download.php or remote authenticated users with a valid Paypal transaction token to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the ref parameter in the (3) orderUpdate function in upload/catalog/extension/payment/paypal.php.

CVE-2015-9226 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
