

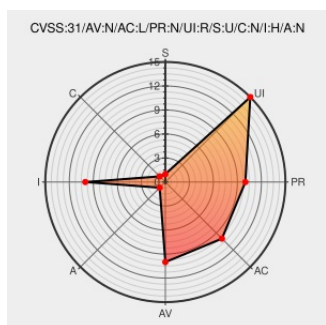

Certain versions of [Alo-easymail](#) from [Alo-easymail Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The alo-easymail plugin before 2.6.01 for WordPress has CSRF with resultant XSS in pages/alo-easymail-admin-options.php.

CVE-2015-9409 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
