

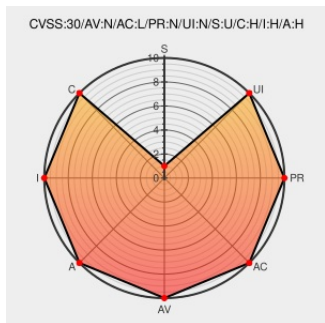

Certain versions of [Pound](#) from [Apsis](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Apsis Pound before 2.8a allows request smuggling via crafted headers, a different vulnerability than CVE-2005-3751.

CVE-2016-10711 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
