

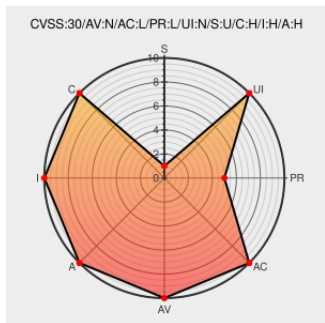

In cPanel before 57.9999.54, /scripts/enablefileprotect exposed TTYs (SEC-117).
