

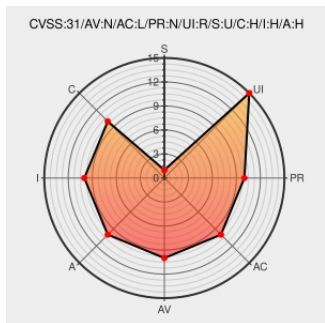

The leenkme plugin before 2.6.0 for WordPress has wp-admin/admin.php?page=leenkme\_facebook CSRF.

CVE-2016-10989 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
