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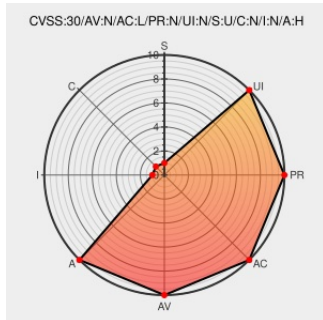

Certain versions of [Dpq3925 8x4 Docsis 3.0 Wireless Residential Gateway With Embedded Digital Voice Adapter](#) from [Cisco](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The administration interface on Cisco DPQ3925 devices with firmware r1 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (device restart) via a crafted HTTP request, aka Bug ID CSCup48105.

CVE-2016-1326 has been assigned by [psirt@cisco.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
