

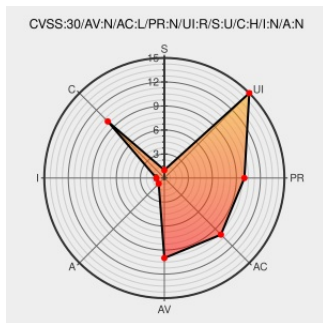

Certain versions of [Iphone Os](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

WebKit in Apple iOS before 9.3 and Safari before 9.1 allows remote attackers to bypass the Same Origin Policy and obtain physical-location data via a crafted geolocation request.

CVE-2016-1779 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
