Certain versions of [Mac Os X](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Captive Network Assistant in Apple OS X before 10.11.5 mishandles a custom URL scheme, which allows user-assisted remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2016-1800 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
