

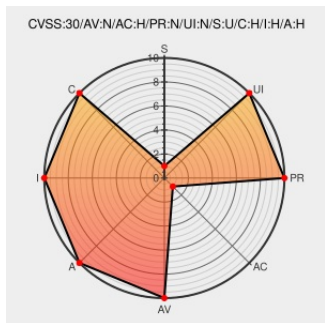

Certain versions of [Oncommand Workflow Automation](#) from [Netapp](#) contain the following vulnerability:

NetApp OnCommand Workflow Automation before 3.1P2 allows remote attackers to bypass authentication via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2016-1894 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
