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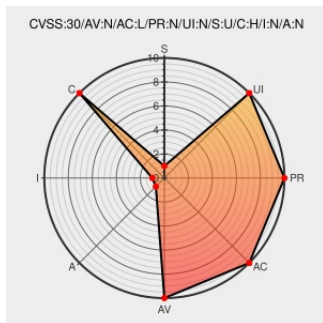

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Certain versions of [Aspect-matrix Building Automation Front-end Solutions Application](#) from [American Auto-matrix](#) contain the following vulnerability:

American Auto-Matrix Aspect-Nexus Building Automation Front-End Solutions application before 3.0.0 and Aspect-Matrix Building Automation Front-End Solutions application allow remote attackers to read arbitrary files via unspecified vectors, as demonstrated by the

configuration file.

CVE-2016-2307 has been assigned by [ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
