Certain versions of [Openmeetings](#) from [Apache](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in the SWF panel in Apache OpenMeetings before 3.1.2 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the swf parameter.

CVE-2016-3089 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
