Description	The Microsoft (1) JScript 9, (2) VBScript, and (3) Chakra JavaScript engines, as used in Microsoft Internet Explorer 9 through 11, contain a vulnerability that could allow an attacker to execute arbitrary code on a system. This vulnerability is caused by a buffer overflow in the JScript 9 engine, which can be exploited by a malicious user. The vulnerability is present in all versions of Internet Explorer 9 through 11, and is not fixed in any of them. The vulnerability is also present in the VBScript and Chakra JavaScript engines, which are used in Internet Explorer 9 through 11.
