

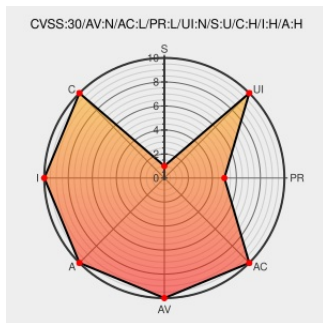

Certain versions of [Endpoint Protection Manager](#) from [Symantec](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Symantec Endpoint Protection Manager (SEPM) 12.1 before RU6 MP5 allows remote authenticated users to discover credentials via a brute-force attack.

CVE-2016-3650 has been assigned by secure@symantec.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
