Certain versions of [Cacti](#) from [Cacti](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in graph_view.php in Cacti 0.8.8.g allows remote authenticated users to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the host_group_data parameter.

CVE-2016-3659 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
