Description	exif.c in Matthias Wandel jhead 2.87, as used in libjhead in Android 4.x before 4.4.4, 5.0.x before 5.0.2, 5.1.x before 5.1.1, and 5.2.x before 5.2.2, allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (crash) via a crafted JPEG image, as demonstrated by a proof of concept exploit.
