Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Synaptics touchscreen driver in Android before 2016-10-05 on Nexus 6P and Android One devices allows attackers to gain privileges via a crafted application, aka internal bug 30141991.

CVE-2016-3940 has been assigned by security@android.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
