

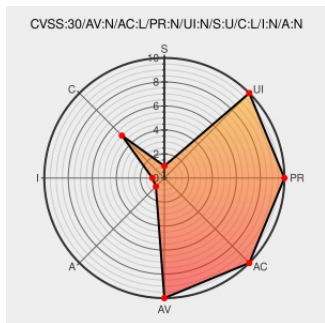

Certain versions of [Experience Manager](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Experience Manager 6.0, 6.1, and 6.2 allow attackers to obtain sensitive audit log event information via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2016-4169 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
