

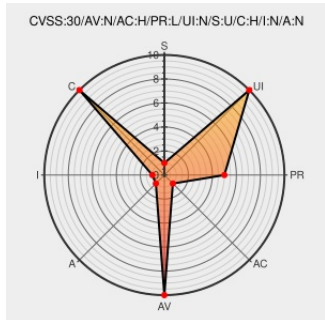

Certain versions of [Mac Os X](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CoreDisplay in Apple OS X before 10.12 allows attackers to view arbitrary users' screens by leveraging screen-sharing access.

CVE-2016-4713 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
