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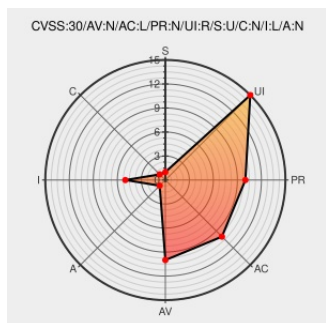

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Certain versions of [Chrome](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple issues in Blink in Google Chrome prior to 54.0.2840.59 for Windows, Mac, and Linux allow a remote attacker to spoof various parts of browser UI via crafted HTML pages.

CVE-2016-5188 has been assigned by [Google](#) security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
