Description	Unspecified vulnerability in the Oracle Customer Interaction History component in Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.1 through 12.2.4 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via a crafted SOAP request, as demonstrated by the SOAPAction header. This vulnerability is not present in Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.5 and later.
