Description	Unspecified vulnerability in the Oracle Customer Interaction History component in Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.1 through 12.2.11.0.0 allows an attacker to execute arbitrary code with system privileges via a crafted SOAP request. The vulnerability is due to a buffer overflow in the SOAP parser. A remote attacker can exploit this vulnerability to execute arbitrary code with system privileges. Oracle has released a patch for this vulnerability.
