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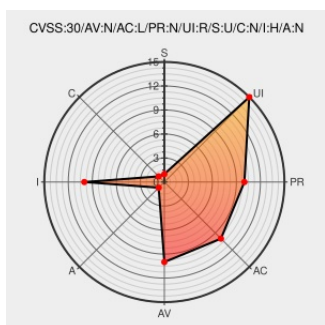

Certain versions of [Access Manager](#) from [Netiq](#) contain the following vulnerability:

NetIQ Access Manager 4.1 before 4.1.2 Hot Fix 1 and 4.2 before 4.2.2 was vulnerable to clickjacking attacks due to a missing SAMEORIGIN filter in the "high encryption" setting.

CVE-2016-5755 has been assigned by security@suse.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
