

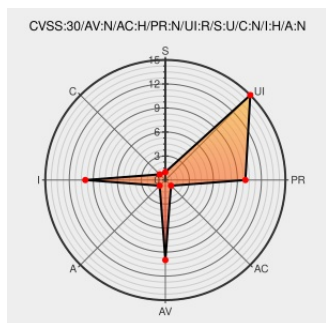

Certain versions of [Edge](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Microsoft Edge allows remote attackers to spoof web content via a crafted web site, aka "Microsoft Edge Spoofing Vulnerability."

CVE-2016-7209 has been assigned by [secure@microsoft.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
