Certain versions of [Phpmyadmin](#) from [Phpmyadmin](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A weakness was discovered where an attacker can inject arbitrary values in to the browser cookies. This is a re-issue of an incomplete fix from PMASA-2016-18.

CVE-2017-1000016 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
