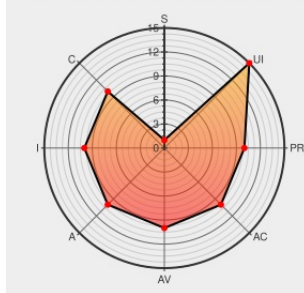

Certain versions of [Poll Scm](#) from [Jenkins](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Poll SCM Plugin was not requiring requests to its API be sent via POST, thereby opening itself to Cross-Site Request Forgery attacks. This allowed attackers to initiate polling of projects with a known name. While Jenkins in general does not consider polling to be a protection-worthy action as it's similar to cache invalidation, the plugin specifically

adds a permission to be able to use this functionality, and this issue undermines that permission.

CVE-2017-1000093 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
