Certain versions of [Frappe](#) from [Frappe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

[ERPNext][Frappe Version <= 7.1.27] SQL injection vulnerability in frappe.share.get_users allows remote authenticated users to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the fields parameter.

CVE-2017-1000120 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
