

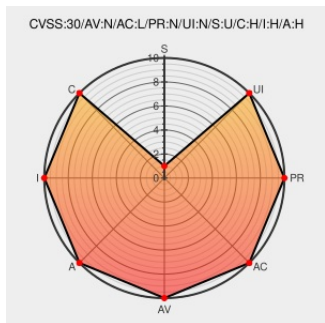

soyuka/pidusage <=1.1.4 is vulnerable to command injection in the module resulting in arbitrary command execution
